This is the way I wash my hands.

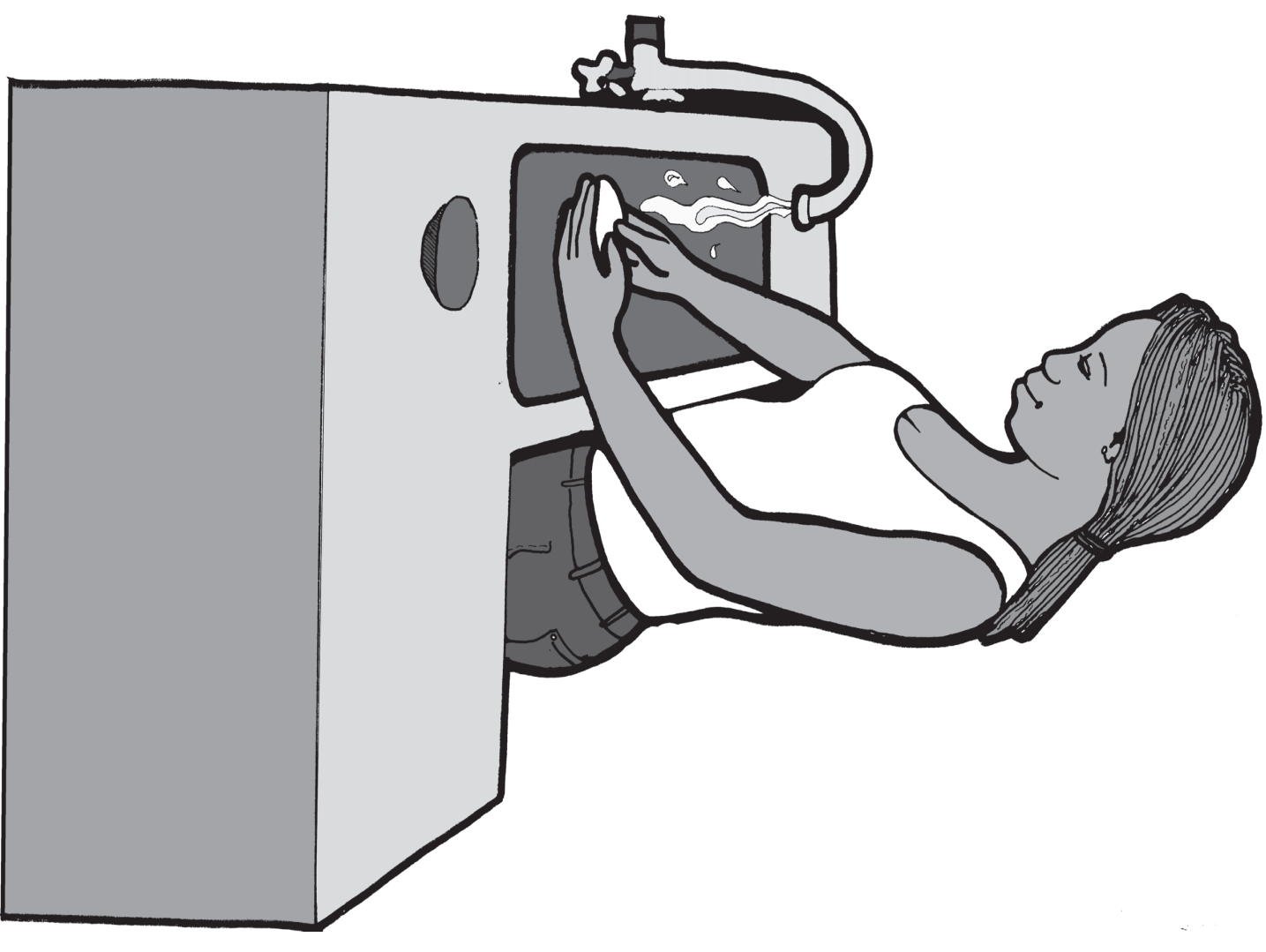
