4. Encourage people to debate on each picture, the more discussion the better.

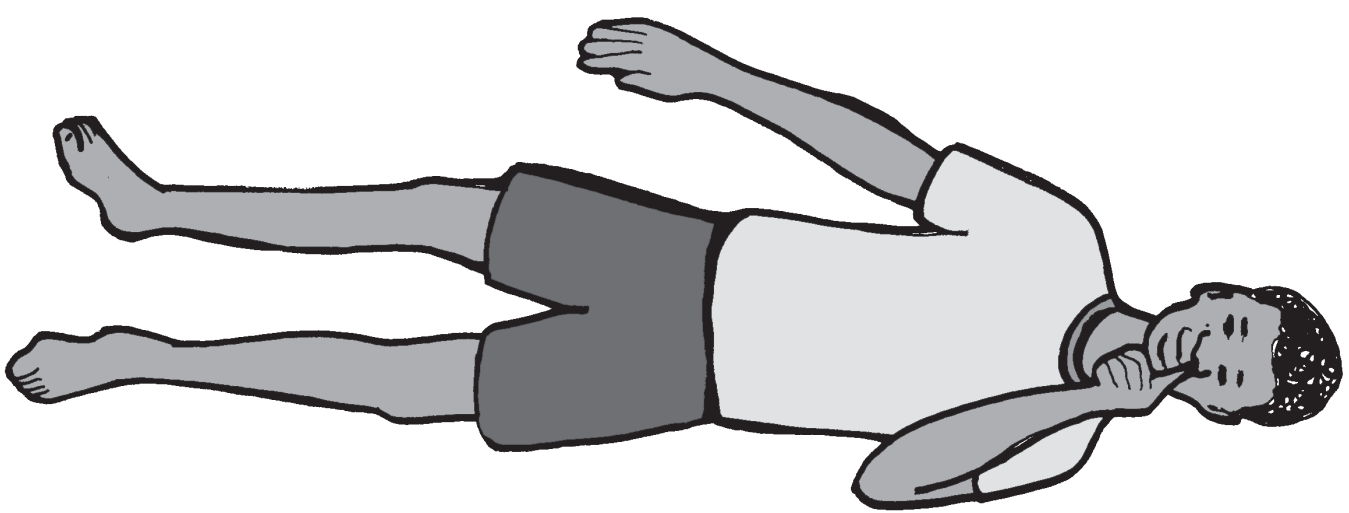
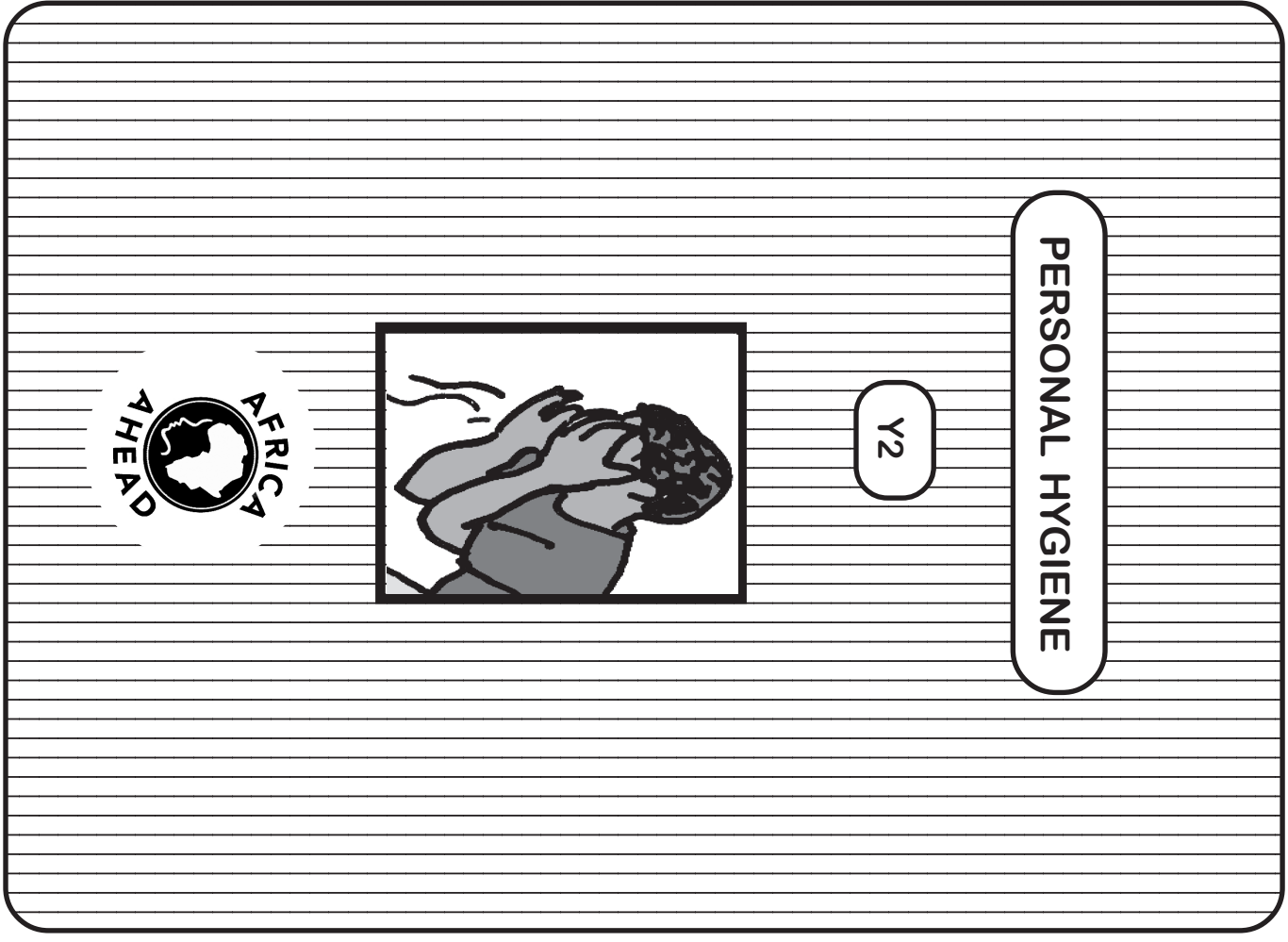
