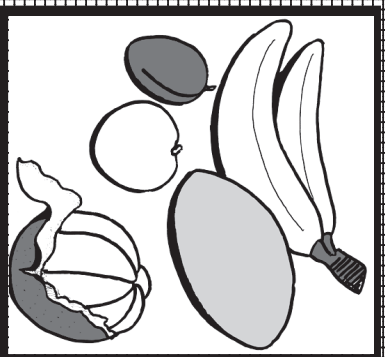

**ACTIVITY:** Three Pile Sorting      1 Hour



1. Give out the T2-T10 Fruit Hygiene pictures to participants.

3. They must ask the audience if their picture is a good practise, or bad, and for what reasons.
4. Encourage people to discuss each picture, the more debate the better.
5. If it is not clear whether the picture is good or bad, it is classified as 'Medium' and a vote taken if the participants cannot resolve the debate.
