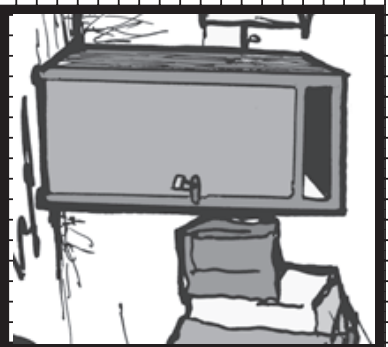

ACTIVITY: Three Pile Sorting 1 Hour

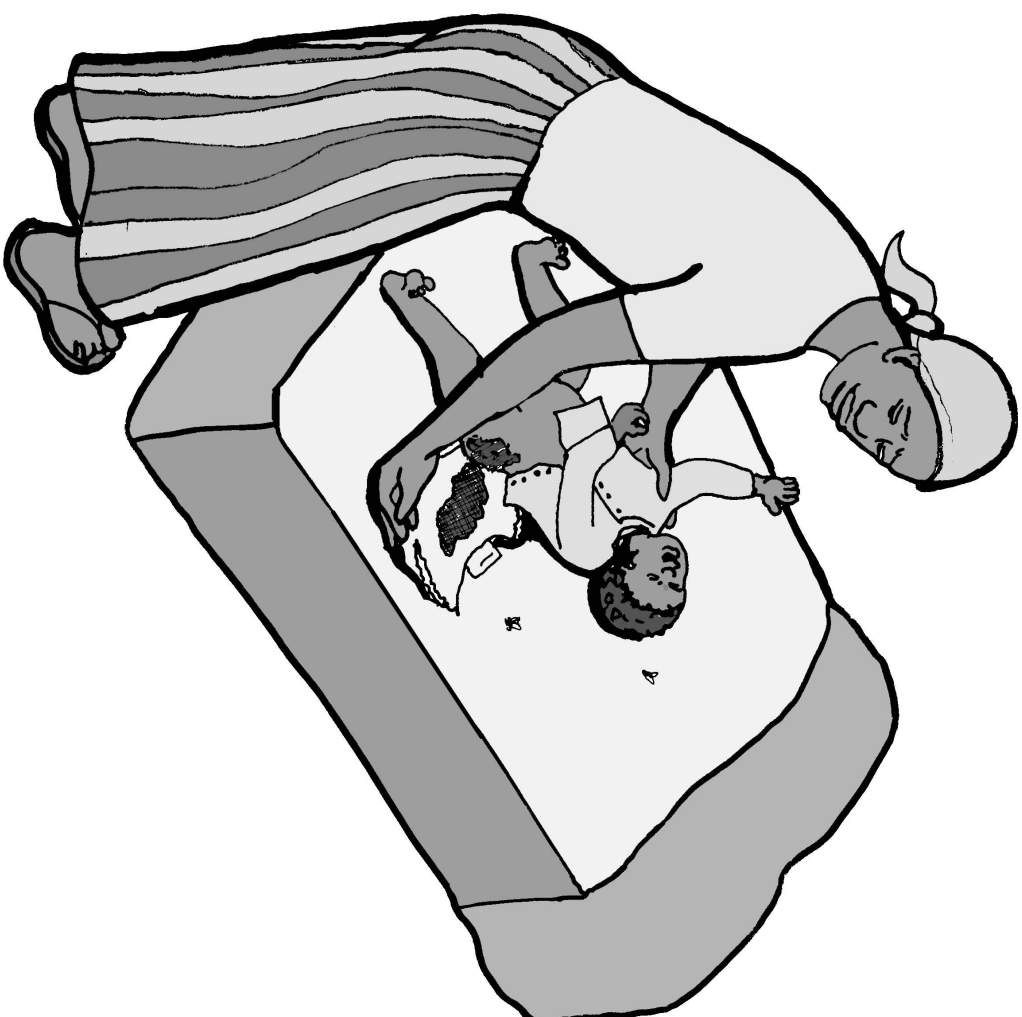
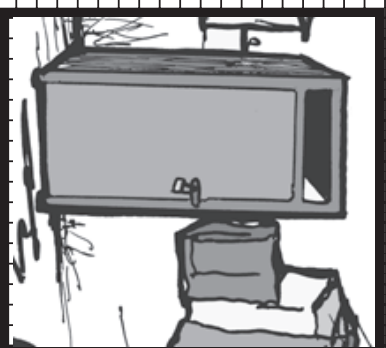
1. Give out the S2-S16 Sanitation pictures to participants.
2. Ask each participant to come up to the front one at a time and explain what they have in their picture.
3. They must ask the audience if their picture is a good practise, or bad, and for what reasons.
4. Encourage people to discuss each picture - the more debate the better.
5. If it is not clear whether the picture is good or bad, it is classified as 'Medium' and a vote taken for the participants to resolve the debate.
