EXPECTED NEW PROJECTS in 2012

Action Contre la Faim - EC Funded: February 2012 - January 2014: \$500 172.00.

The EC-WF collaboration with ACF has been delayed since May, due to compliance constraints of ACF, but it is now due to start in January 2012. The MoU is signed and we have restarted active engagement with ACF to that effect. Project staff have been recruited and waiting for the start up date. We will have one Programme Manager, 2 District Team Leaders and 9 Project Officers. Work will be in 5 wards of Gutu and 6 wards of Mberengwa District. The project will run for 2 years with public health promotion through 450 villages. The target is challenging in that ACF want 'total coverage' by getting one member from *every* household into the CHC (30 per CHC) in 11 wards, with a population 82,000. This aims to raise water and sanitation coverage from the current 40% to 85%. ACF will subsidize the piloting of the 13,400 UVIP (one bag version) in the same area coming just after we create the demand for sanitation to achieve Zero Open Defecation.

CAFOD consortium:

In October 2011 ZimAHEAD was invited to a consortium partnering CRS, Dabane Trust and IWSD under the leadership of CAFOD on a US\$.2.2 million dollar DFID funded one year WASH project. A concept note has been submitted and we await the response from DFID but CAFOD states that they have been assured the funding is available to start early 2012. There is no clear indication of where it would be or the extent ZA can be involved.

USAID /OFDA has asked us to implement in Masvingo Rural and Urban, Chiredzi and Makoni Districts. This would involve 4 new project Officers, 240 CHC facilitators, running two clubs each of 75 members, making a total of 216,000 beneficiaries and 11 EHTs for monitoring the programme. This would involve health promotion training and the promotion of Water Guard for protection of drinking water at point of use.

Oxfam has applied to OFDA for further funding and we have been verbally assured to be included owing to the good project delivery we have done in the past OFDA cycles and the good working relationships enjoyed between ZA and Oxfam.

Medair are happy to continue with us as consultants after their last project in Gokwe. (page 9).
