

CHCs in an Integrated Context

CHCs are being *taken to scale* & have become an integral part of national **Environmental Health Promotion** programmes.

In Rwanda & Zimbabwe integrated **WASH / Nutrition** programmes are being implemented (USAID funds) to address **Stunting and Poverty reduction.** AfDB +BMGF big focus on stunting.

CHCs are being taken to scale to empower women and mobilize communities to become more self-sufficient in a practical, low-cost and sustainable way.

In IDP camps of Northern Uganda 18,844 people had been registered as active CHC members within just 4 months!!






